Township Board Meeting Minutes
September 13, 2021

1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER

Chair Emery Maher called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

2. APPROVE MEETING MINUTES

Motion made by Emery to approve the minutes as read; Larry seconded. All voted in favor; motion carried.

3. NEW BUSINESS

Todd Greseth, Goodhue County Commissioner attended the meeting to share updates from the County. The garbage ordinance is still in the courts awaiting appeal and soon going to the higher court. Todd was wondering if Townships adopted their own garbage ordinance if we could override the County? Darla will write the MAT attorney to ask. Todd is pushing for the County to direct some of the ARPA funds towards safety issues like updating radios, pagers and fire fighter gear.

Bryan Eggum applied for a building permit to replace a garage. He would like to use the original footprint but add on additional feet. The original garage did not meet the front yard setbacks as written in our ordinances. His options are to replace the shed on the exact same foundation adding no additional square footage or apply for a variance. The permit was not signed.

The road agreement with Stanton Township for 340th Street Way was discussed and agreed upon. Darla will update the contract to reflect Stanton pays Warsaw \$2,000 annually and the prorated amount of \$1666.80 for 2020 starting from the date when the Bergeson permit was approved by the County. Larry made motion to accept the annual road maintenance fee and the prorated amount for 2020; Emery seconded. All voted in favor; motion carried.

The new owners of the Murray property would like to build a house and had questions about putting in a driveway. The Supervisors ask that they come to a meeting and bring drawings. There are not questions about the building site for the house.

Emery has been trying to contact the Green family for permission to add a turnaround on 35th Ave. He will keep up posted on the progress.

Motion made by Larry to adjourn the meeting; Duwain seconded. All in favor; motion carried.
