Township Board Meeting Minutes

December 8, 2025

CALL TO ORDER

Chair Madsen called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES

TOWNSHIP ELECTION TRAINING AND DEADLINES

- **December 31 – January 14:** Candidate filing period. Filing closes January 14 at 5 p.m. The office must be open from 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. on January 14.
- **January 16:** Last day for a candidate to withdraw.
- **February 7:** Absentee voting begins.

2026 KENYON FIRE CONTRACT

The 2025 contract was \$3,957.17.

The 2026 proposed contract is \$4,027.14 — an increase of \$69.97.

No one from the Township attended the fire district meeting.
